Yellow Ribbon Program

Vanderbilt University does not limit the number of students in the yellow ribbon program in each school. The Law School and the Owen Graduate School of Management award up to \$10,000 in yellow ribbon funds based on the unmet need of a student; all other schools award yellow ribbon funds up to \$6,000 of unmet need.

Yellow ribbon funds are distributed after the national cap for the Post-9/11 bill has been expended. Yellow ribbon funds are awarded for each semester or session in which the student has requested certification provided that the student has unmet need.

If you believe that you meet the criteria for the yellow ribbon program, please complete the form below and return with a copy of your certificate of eligibility (COE) and the service member's DD-214. The school certifying official (SCO) will review the request and notify you at your Vanderbilt email address whether or not you are eligible for yellow ribbon funds.
