



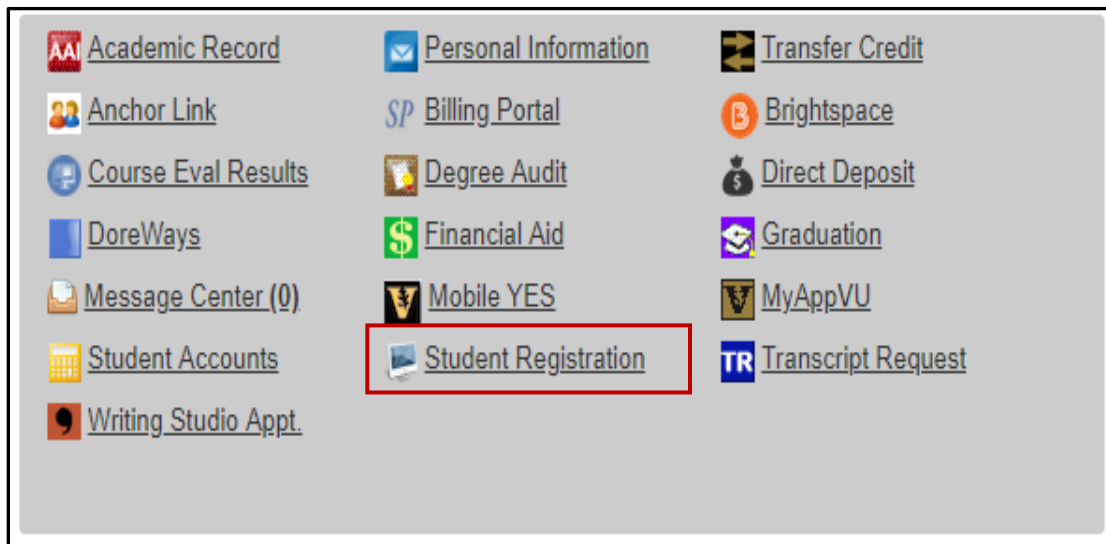
YES User Guide

Catalog Search And Academic Planner

The YES Catalog is a full listing of all courses approved at Vanderbilt. Available year-round through the Student Registration application, the Catalog features search functionality similar to that within the YES Schedule. In addition, it contains an Academic Planner tool that allows students to organize preferred courses and plan out their academic career.

YES Catalog Search

1. On the Student Landing page, click **Student Registration**.



2. From the menu at the top of the page, select **Catalog**.



3. Enter the Subject Area, Course Number, or Title into the Text Box and click **Search**.

4. Once you click **Search**, all courses that meet the search criteria will appear. New courses will appear with a blue flag around the number, indicating that the course is not yet available.

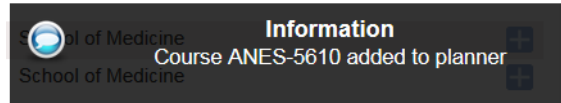

Description

This course is designed to emphasize the concepts of coordinated perioperative medicine and enhanced recovery after surgery (ERAS). Evidence-based guidelines, optimization/standardization of perioperative care, and multimodal strategies to decrease postoperative morbidities are key components of ERAS. The student will function as integral part of the Perioperative Anesthesia Consult Service and learn fundamental aspects of anesthetic care that maximize perioperative pain control and reduce morbidity and healthcare costs related to cardiac, pulmonary, renal, endocrine, PONV complications or surgical site infections. The student will have an opportunity to be involved in the preoperative, intraoperative, and postoperative management of surgical patients on ERAS pathways.








1. From the Catalog search page, click on the **Planner** box in the top, right-hand corner.

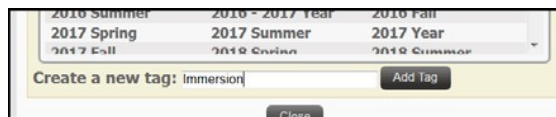

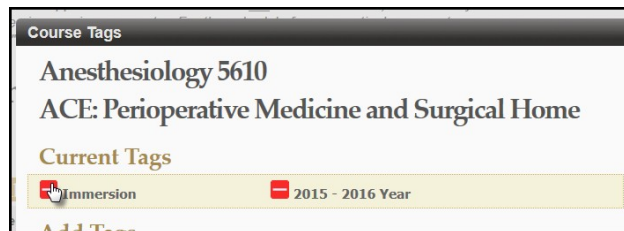
3. Click on the  icon to delete a course from your planner, or click on the  icon to tag a course with various attributes.
 - You can tag each course with built-in term tags . . .



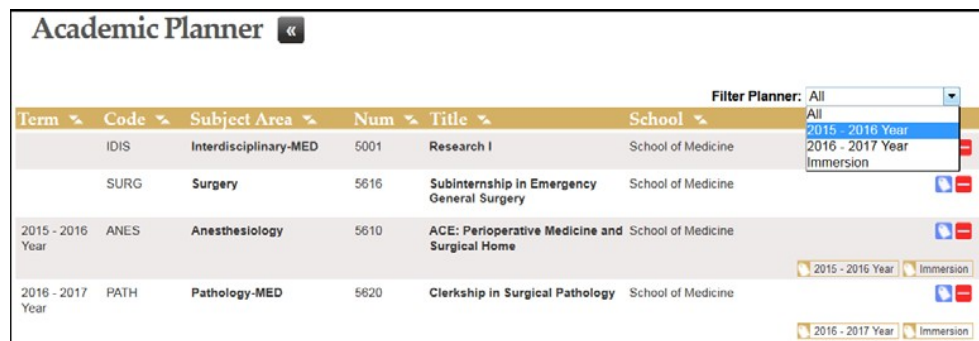
- . . . and/or create your own unique tags.

- Once tags have been added, you can delete them by clicking on the  icon within the Course Tags window.

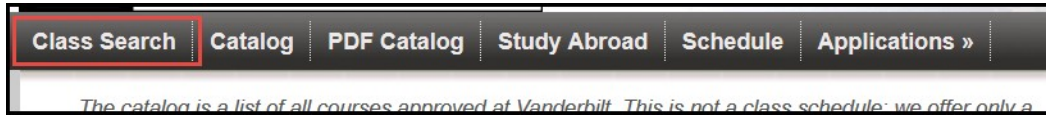


- Tags will appear in your planner list. You can also filter the list by tags.




Using the Planner with the Class Search

1. You can search for scheduled sections of courses in your planner using the Advanced Search in the Class Search. Select Class Search from the menu.



2. Select **Advanced Search**, then click on the Tags drop-down menu to choose your tag(s).
